What Makes PSW a Leading Healthcare Innovation Population Health Company?

What initially began as an endeavor focused solely on Medicare Advantage operations has now grown into a multifaceted entity, offering a comprehensive range of service offerings in the value-based care marketplace. Today, PSW proudly stands as a trusted advisor in the field, guiding healthcare providers, policymakers, and stakeholders alike. As the demand for efficient and value-based healthcare intensifies, PSW continues to play an integral role in shaping the future of healthcare delivery.

Starting its first Medicare ACO in 2017, PSW has emerged as a major player in the ACO landscape, garnering credibility not only in the state of Washington but across the nation.

PSW has continuously generated positive results that cement its place as a leader in value-based care. PSW's Medicare ACO has grown to support various types of providers across the Pacific Northwest from independent providers to critical access hospitals and rural health clinics to urban health systems. Throughout this growth period, PSW elevated its ACO management capabilities to support participants in performance improvement and reporting. This has allowed PSW to position its networks to achieve the best possible chance for positive performance. Generating over \$120 Million in gross savings to Medicare and achieving an average quality score of

95%, PSW's ACOs rank among the highest performers in the space. Specifically, one of PSW's ACOs held the #1 spot for lowest overall post-acute care spending for three years in a row. PSW now has ACO providers in the Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP) and the ACO Realizing Equity, Access, and Community Health (REACH) Model.

PSW CEO, Melanie Matthews, has also spent a great deal of time advocating for policy changes on behalf of ACOs. Melanie recently testified before the U.S. Senate Committee on Finance to promote the positive impact of ACOs and the benefits that these programs provide to Medicare patients with chronic conditions. This hearing sparked a debate on the need for payment reform and a system that incentivizes providers to become more accountable for the overall care of their patients.

Progressing Toward Healthcare Transformation Through Innovation and Collaboration

As PSW began progressing in ACO performance, they began the search for a new partner that would assist in data aggregation and reporting. After a thorough search period and rounds of evaluations, PSW found Innovaccer to be ready and willing to help upgrade its population health management to the next level. PSW engaged in a pilot period with Innovaccer to explore using their platform, state-of-the-art analytics and reporting, and care management solutions. The initial six-month pilot yielded exceptional results for the 10,000 PSW lives managed on the Innovaccer platform, setting the stage for a promising collaboration.

PSW continued to advance in its commitment to delivering quality care and seamless patient experiences, which led them to begin identifying key initiatives to improve patient outcomes. In partnership with Innovaccer, PSW uncovered a need to focus on addressing avoidable Emergency Department (ED) utilization related to Urinary Tract Infections (UTIs). By harnessing Innovaccer's analytics and reporting tools, along with effective care management solutions, PSW was able to generate actionable insights from the aggregated Admit, Discharge, Transfer (ADT) feeds. Through these interventions, PSW saw a clear impact on performance as avoidable ED utilization related to UTIs was reduced by nearly 12%.

PSW also leveraged Innovaccer analytics as they enhanced their engagement with Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs). PSW has a long history of working collaboratively with SNFs and finding new ways to incentivize them to partner on value-based care efforts. Innovaccer's analytics gave PSW a new view to track high-performing SNFs and identify opportunities for performance improvement.

PSW advanced its data-sharing capabilities with these SNFs and worked to address utilization trends. Through these efforts, PSW was able to reduce SNF utilization by 16.7% from 2022 to 2023 and lower the average length of stay by 8.1% during the same period.

Building on the success of these initiatives, PSW evaluated new ways to leverage Innovaccer's capabilities. PSW's growth in ACO lives and other value-based arrangements allowed PSW to expand the populations included in its partnership with Innovaccer. This led to an increase of over 60,000 commercial lives that PSW brought into the Innovaccer platform by the end of 2020. PSW fully utilized Innovaccer's comprehensive suite of population health management solutions, solidifying its commitment to delivering exceptional care and driving better patient outcomes.

PSW was able to do this through the Innovaccer platform, which facilitates the scaling of population health management by providing a comprehensive suite of repeatable solutions that can be seamlessly adapted for each new line of business.
